

BARC Raffles – Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility

Participants must be 18 years of age or older to purchase a raffle ticket or claim a prize, in accordance with Pennsylvania law.

Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

2. Licensing & Compliance

This raffle is conducted under the authority of a valid Small Games of Chance license issued to BARC Developmental Services, a registered nonprofit organization in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

All proceeds from the raffle will be used to support the charitable mission of BARC Developmental Services, in compliance with the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act.

3. Raffle Period

One prize will be drawn each day. Winners will be selected at random from all eligible entries.

4. Prizes

Prizes are non-transferable and may not be exchanged for cash (except where the prize is a cash award).

BARC Developmental Services reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if necessary.

5. Ticket Sales

Tickets may be purchased in person or online (if permitted by law).

Credit card payments are processed through a third-party payment processor. BARC Developmental Services does not store or have access to your credit card information.

All ticket sales are final. No refunds will be issued.

6. Winner Notification

Winners will be notified using the contact information provided on the ticket stub.

Winners may be asked to present a valid government-issued photo ID to claim their prize.

If a winner cannot be contacted or does not claim their prize within 30 days, the prize may be forfeited.

7. Publicity

By accepting a prize, winners consent to the use of their name and likeness for promotional purposes without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law.

8. Limitation of Liability

BARC Developmental Services is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, or incomplete entries, or for any technical or human error that may occur in the administration of the raffle.
