

## **Duck Derby – Terms & Conditions**

### **How It Works**

Duck adoptions represent the purchase of a chance to win a prize. Ducks do not physically race. Each adopted duck is assigned a unique number. All ducks are placed into a pool, and winning ducks are randomly selected during the Duck Derby drawing. Winners are determined entirely by chance.

### **Eligibility**

Participants must be 18 years of age or older. The Duck Derby is conducted by BARC Developmental Services, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.

### **Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded based on the posted prize structure. Winners will be announced at the time of the drawing and/or contacted following the event. Prizes are non-transferable and may not be substituted unless otherwise stated.

### **Drawing Date & Time**

The Duck Derby drawing will be held on the date and time listed at [www.barcprograms.org/duck-derby](http://www.barcprograms.org/duck-derby).

### **Severe Weather or Event Changes**

In the event of severe weather, unsafe conditions, or unforeseen circumstances, BARC reserves the right to adjust the time, date, or format of the drawing. If changes are required, updates will be communicated via BARC's website and social media channels. The drawing will occur as soon as reasonably possible.

### **Compliance**

The Duck Derby is conducted in accordance with Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance regulations. All drawings are conducted using a randomized selection process to ensure fairness.
