BARC Developmental Services Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2024-2025:

**Financial Statement**

In fiscal year 2024-25, the agency obtained additional funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services, Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) to fund increasing costs which are necessary to continue to support the individuals' ongoing and changing needs in our ICF homes. We were awarded a supplemental payment from ODP to help fund the training costs for staff credentialing.

Fiscal Year 2024-25 closed with a surplus on annual expenses of \$30,354,000 offset by revenue of \$31,403,000. As of 6/30/25, assets were \$18,947,000 and liabilities were \$7,160,000 for net assets of \$11,787,000.
